Wellness by the Numbers

The recent cost of U.S. healthcare expenditures was

\$3.6 trillion.



6 in 10 adults suffer from a chronic disease, such as heart disease, diabetes and cancer.

90% of the nation's annual health expenditures are for people suffering with mental and chronic conditions.



Nearly 18% of the nation's annual gross domestic product (GPD) was spent on health expenses.

Healthier employees have 41% lower health-related costs than employees in

poor health.



Participation in a disease management program reduced health care costs by roughly \$136 per member, per month and reduced hospital admissions by 30%.
